**DELAY OF SECOND ROUND OF PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON THE TUTUKA  
MINIMUM EMISSION STANDARDS (MES) POSTPONEMENT APPLICATION**

It is with regret that we write to inform you that we have decided to delay the second round of public comment (including the two public meetings) to a later date on the Tutuka Power Station MES postponement application. In putting information into the public domain it is essential that Eskom's position in respect of the postponement applications and future commitments to the installation of abatement equipment at Tutuka be presented unequivocally.

Changes in senior management at Eskom have been widely publicised in the media and it is as a result of those changes that additional time is now needed to allow the Eskom commitments to be confirmed. It is the view of both the independent consultants and Eskom that delaying the start of the second round of consultation to confirm key information and commitments is in the best interest of effective consultation.

We will notify all registered stakeholders of the revised schedule in due course and apologise for any inconvenience that may be caused by this delay.
